

SkillsUSA Maryland State Championship 2022 Photography Contest Update

Part 1: Field Assignment (Time to completion: 1 hour)

Students will go on assignment and capture images that relate to a “theme” using their own supplied digital camera & accessories. Students must demonstrate their ability to stay within the parameters with respect to:

- a. Location
- b. Theme
- c. Time limit
- d. Technical and artistic proficiency

Part 2: Written Test (Time to completion: 30 mins)

Students will be tested on a wide variety of topics. Questions include areas on:

- a. Quality of Light
- b. Digital SLR Features/Functions
- c. Photo Basics
- d. Digital Imaging

Part 3: Digital Editing (Not timed, due 15 mins before contest end)

Students will be required to complete a digital image manipulation project using their school or personal computer and available version of Adobe Photoshop.

Part 4: Print Competition (Not timed)

Students are required to submit 2 prints that will be scored by a panel of professional judges. Particular attention will be given to:

- a. the technical & artistic aspects of the image
- b. the overall impact
- c. images must be 11x14 mounted to 16x20 foam core. Use 16x20 black matting with an 11x14 window to match print size.
- d. NOTE: This is a Photography competition and not Graphic Design. Over-manipulation of images is not

CONTESTANTS REQUIRED ITEMS

1. Laptop with a copy of Adobe Photoshop loaded.
2. Digital SLR or high-end mirrorless camera & lens
3. 2 Memory Cards (16GB min) – FORMATTED / EMPTY!!!
4. Extra camera batteries
5. Speedlight Flash & light meters (helpful but not mandatory)
6. Camera’s USB cable or SD card adapter for downloading images to computer
7. Pencil

IMPORTANT: Please be sure to equip your student with the computer's password and authorization to save files to the hard drive. Also, practice using the student's smartphone hotspot feature to access your Adobe account to boot Photoshop and/or Lightroom. Wifi access on site is never a guarantee.
