SUBMIT YOUR RESUME

New for this year's National Leadership and Skills Conference, SkillsUSA has developed a new online tool for competitors to upload their resumes for the National Technical Committee (*the contest overseers*) prior to NLSC. Please upload your resume by Tuesday, June 21 to ensure that your technical committee has time to process your submission. Note that failing to submit a resume may result in a score penalty.

NOTE: You will receive a message indicating that your resume has been successfully submitted along with a confirmation email following your submission.

STEP 2

TAKE YOUR PROFESSIONAL DEVELOPMENT TEST

SkillsUSA's Professional Development Test is now an online, pre-conference test. This new delivery method allows you to choose the best time for you to take the test. This test covers basic SkillsUSA Knowledge along with the SkillsUSA Framework and is worth 2.5% of your overall contest score. Competitors may not utilize any external reference materials, resources or persons during their test and must complete the test in a proctored environment. Qualifying proctors are school system employees who are not the competitor's SkillsUSA Advisor.

Below you will find your personal credentials to sign-in to your test. To access the testing platform, you and your proctor must submit the digital Proctor and Security Agreement Form. You may take your test anytime between now and Tuesday, June 22 at 5 p.m.. Any test submitted after 5 p.m. **WILL NOT** be scored as a part of your overall Career Competition Event score and could impact your placement. Please complete this requirement as soon as possible to ensure yourself ample time to complete the test.
