<u>Item #2: 2024 National Leadership and Skills Conference (NLSC) Information</u> Students earning gold medals at the 2024 State Championship are eligible to represent Maryland at the SkillsUSA National Leadership and Skills Conference (NLSC) in Atlanta, Georgia, **June 24-29, 2024**. The SkillsUSA "Team Maryland" delegation will be returning to the beautiful Atlanta Marriott Marquis, 265 Peachtree Center Avenue NE, Atlanta, GA 30303.

The NLSC is a five-day / five-night conference experience, arriving Monday morning or afternoon, June 24, 2024, and departing anytime Saturday, June 29, 2024.

The **2024 NLSC registration fee for Maryland participants is \$325.00 per person**. This fee includes both the National SkillsUSA conference registration cost and Maryland-specific extras including, T-shirt, trading pins, conference gifts, Monday evening *Welcome Dinner and Orientation* (7 pm) and Friday evening *Maryland Awards*

## Item #3: ACTION ITEM! Online Technical Tests for State Gold Medalists!

Tests are located on the same testing platform used for the SkillsUSA PD test. Technical test scores will not affect or alter state contest scores in any way. Remind students that test questions might be the same or similar to national competition tests!

## Item #4: NLSC Hotel Registration – Atlanta Marriott Marquis

To ensure accurate rooming/roommate selection and billing for advisors and students attending the national conference, advisors will **assign and pay** for rooms for their own chapter delegations. NLSC room rates at the Atlanta Marriott Marquis are **\$235.00 per room/per night**. Students should be assigned to double-double rooms, **2-4 per room.** Adults only in single rooms.
