Health Knowledge Bowl Contest Update (3/14/25)

As you prepare for the Health Knowledge Bowl Competition on March 29th, please make sure to read the Technical Standards for Health Knowledge Bowl. A few items are emphasized below:

- Clothing Requirements:
 - SkillsUSA Official Dress (see Technical Standards) or business attire that is neat and professional looking. Examples of this are listed below:
 - Jackets or blazers with matching pants or skirt (knee length or longer)
 - A collared, button up shirt with tie combination
 - A conservative shirt or blouse
 - Dress shoes, heels (closed-toe), or flats
- Materials and Equipment Requirements Supplied by the **TEAM**:
 - a. 8 1/2" by 11" blank white paper (**enough for the competition**) – at minimum 55 sheets are necessary but please bring extra just in case
 - b. 8 1/2" by 11" blank colored paper for use as scrap paper
 - c. Pens, pencils, and black marking pens (no ultrafine markers)
 - d. Calculator four function or scientific acceptable (**cannot be a graphing calculator or a cellphone**)
 - These will be the only allowed materials at the testing tables
- Resumes:
 - **A one-page, one-sided resume is to be submitted online prior to the day of the competition for each competitor/team member.** See online submission guidelines on technical standards packet for more information.
 - I recommended also bringing a neat, hard copy the day of the competition just in case.
- Tie Breakers:
 - If there is need for a tie breaker, the team with the highest written test score will break it
 - The SkillsUSA Professional Development Test that is completed online may also be used as a tie breaker
- Spectators/Observers:
 - There will be **NO** spectators/observers allowed in the competition
- Personal Belongings:
 - All personal belongings will be placed in the front of the classroom next to the contest chair at the start of the competition.
 - Any electronic device (laptop, cellphone, tablet, smart watches), should be turned OFF and placed in your bag prior to entering the competition classroom. There will be no access to these belongings during the 15-minute break of the bowl portion.
 - Failure to comply may lead to disqualification of your team in the competition
