Item #2: Time to Register for the Fall Leadership Conference!

Registration is open for the FLC and will close on **Wednesday, October 15, 2025**. The annual conference is returning to the Carousel Hotel in Ocean City, Maryland, **November 6-7, 2025**.

Registration fees for students, advisors, chaperones and bus drivers is **\$175.00** per person and hotel rooms are **\$130.00** per room. Single rooms are for adults only, and students can be housed 2-4 per room. Plan to arrive Thursday, November 6, by 12 noon and depart Friday, November 7, 2:30pm. Three meals are provided for all registered participants (Thursday dinner, Friday breakfast and lunch).

Up to thirty-five (35) students and advisors can participate per chapter (we recommend 1 chaperone for every 10 students). Contact the state director if you would like to bring more students to FLC - approved on a space-available basis.

The SkillsUSA Conference Management System (CMS) is an easy way to register you and your chapter members for the FLC.
