HVAC Competition – Clothing Requirements

To ensure safety, professionalism, and uniformity during the competition, all contestants must adhere to the following clothing requirements:

- 1. Clean, clear safety glasses must be worn at all times.**
- 2. Safety toe boots are required.**
- 3. Work gloves must be worn as appropriate for tasks.**
- 4. Clothing must be free of rips, tears, or excessive wear.**
- 5. Baggy or loose-fitting clothing is not permitted.**
- 6. Cuffed pants are not allowed.**
- 7. A belt must be worn at all times.**
- 8. Shirts must be tucked in at all times.**
